## 1988 -1991 CIVIC/CRX Interior & Exterior Label Replacement Instructions




### Step 1:

For best results, you may consider removing switches from the vehicle before applying the labels. Although, all labels can be applied while the switches and other components are still mounted to the vehicle, please use your best judgement on what you feel more comfortable with.

### Step 2:

Using a required pick (shown below), remove the existing labels (Item 2 shown in figure 2.1, below) and debris from the switches (Item 1) & other components. To remove item 2 from the switch you will carefully insert the pick into the corner of the original decal cover, shown with the red circle. This must be done carefully. Make sure that you do not drag the pick over the surface as any scratches in the switch will show through new decal.





**Note:** If you have a defrost switch similar to the one shown below, make sure to separate the clear covering from the backing and keep the black backing which is what the new decal will adhere to.





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## Step 3:

Thoroughly clean surfaces where the new labels will be applied with the alcohol prep pad (provided). Due to the adhesive previously applied on many of these components, do not towel dry upon wiping with the prep pad. Particles from the towel will tend to stick to these components.



## Step 4:

Once the components are completely dry after being wiped down with the alcohol pad, it is time to apply the new decals. For the switch decals that have a cutout for a light, it is best to remove this cutout while still on the decal sheet. This can be done by lifting a corner of the decal until the center is off the paper and then poking the cutout through with the plastic pick that was provided. Then, use this pick to lightly attach a corner of each of the new decals. Be sure that all decal and pick surfaces are clean & dry. The smallest spec of dirt or debris can alter the success of this installation. These decals are printed on a pressure sensitive material. This means that the more pressure you apply when applying the decals, the more permanent they will become. Take your time to make sure that decals are placed in the center of items so that they are as close to identical to what was there.

### Step 5:

Carefully reinstall all switches and components with new labels & enjoy for years.
